Upcoming & Recap of Events

- PAC/Tball fields: storage sheds will hopefully be built by mid-March.
- 2020 Rental Plans: would like to rent big field to teams not involved with little league age players. Possibility of west-end field space to be rented out for soccer, but for their fall season only. Spring soccer and baseball combined causes too much congestion at facility, mostly parking issues.
- Paving: League is hoping to work with County to forgive some, or all, of our annual fee to allow us to use the funds toward paving pathways.
