Registration & Return To Play

- In our registration program, we'll turn on the request for players to login and pay now
- As we look to start the season (currently Clark County is in Phase 2), we'll plan for the following:
 - Max of 75 people at a field: masks are required
 - Hand sanitizer available at each field
 - Defense provides ball while in the field
 - Players spread out along bull pen to keep distanced
 - Umps don't touch the ball and may call from behind the plate or the mound

Coaches

- After a motion by Adam and a second by Casey, all people that registered to volunteer as coaches were approved. More will be needed to be recruited at the PAC and AL levels.

Player Evaluations

- Will be held on 3/13; only for AL and NL levels
- Only players permitted, no parents inside evaluation area
- Will create online sign-ups for groups of 5
- Manager and one coach permitted during evaluations
- PAC will be scored based on numbers from prior years to create/balance teams

Practice Fields

- Planning for all to be at HB Fuller fields. Adam will handle schedules and will book practices on Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays.

Cage Schedules

- Adam will handle schedules for cages
- Coaches and one team parent will be allowed in cages for practice. One of them will check all temperatures and record in book.
- Checklist of symptoms will be posted

- Masks required in cages. Casey may be able to get an emergency backup supply donated.

Maintenance and Improvements

- Paving project: ground has still been too soft
- Concession stand: county is needing to complete inspection. Due to repairs underway they gave us a few more weeks
- Tilling will be needed on AL & NL fields.
- Work days need to be scheduled

Community Collaboration

- Jordan Wiggins and Jackson Evans would like to host clinics. Since these may not be feasible to due health & safety restrictions, we will see if they'd like to help at practices.
- Skyview will be using the big field from 4/12-June
