

## Parent Code of Conduct

I Agree To...

- 1) Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game and practice, on and off the field.
- 2) Place the emotional and physical well-being of ALL players ahead of a personal desire to win.
- 3) Help my child follow the athlete's code of conduct, team agreements, coaches' instructions and rules.
- 4) Understand the mandatory play requirements and know that some of the players will only get the basic requirement in each game which may be just 6 defensive outs and one at bat or may be just one at bat (this is determined by the number of players rostered) and it could happen in all games.
- 5) Accept the authority of the coaches to determine strategy and player selection and placement.
- 6) Provide positive general encouragement to ALL players and will not give them specific direction during games.
- 7) Not address or criticize umpires, blaming them for game outcomes. Umpires are trained volunteers that do the best they can.
- 8) Ensure that my child attends all scheduled practices and contests. If my child is not able to make a scheduled practice or contest, they will be responsible for contacting the coach in advance.
- 9) Support the team and our league by volunteering to help when asked and assist where requested.
- 10) Make certain that any guests or family members that come to games follow these guidelines too.
- 11) Remember that I am representing the game, my league, my team and my family at all times.
- 12) I will not attempt to do any coaching from the stands with any player we pitch and move fielders for each batter this is counterproductive and an unwanted distraction to the individual and the coaching staff.

- 8) NOT address or otherwise criticize opposing coaches or players, unless spoken to first.
- 9) Strive to have a positive attitude in the way I talk and listen to my teammates, parents, and coaches.
- 10) Accept that following these codes will impact the coach's decisions regarding my role on the team.
- 11) Understand that I may only receive mandatory minimum play in each game, which could be just one at bat and 6 defensive outs and one at bat or may be just one at bat (this is determined by the number of players rostered) and it could happen in all games.

- 13) Uniform wore properly while it is on my body, hats are on straight, bill forward and jerseys are ALWAYS tucked in.
